ASPIS

ASPIS is the cluster of three consortia funded under the European Commission's call for projects advancing the safety assessment of chemicals without animal testing: RISK-HUNT3R, ONTOX, and PrecisionTox (website).

ASPIS represents more than 70 institutions across 16 European countries and the U.S. delivering on a \notin 60 million investment in providing timely answers about chemical effects on human health.

The 2nd ASPIS open symposium presents the joint efforts of the cluster.

Day #1 will focus on the technology supporting the cluster. Different applications of new approach methods (NAMs: non-animal-based test methods) will be presented, including qAOP approaches, omics technologies, kinetics predictions, and computational methods.

Day #2 will focus on their implementation and impact in risk assessment strategies and their broader dissemination.

- Increasing confidence in and promoting NAM regulatory uptake;
- Delineating foreseen ASPIS impact on regulatory issues;
- Engaging young researchers and supporting scientific networking;
- Facilitating interactions among ASPIS and international stakeholders.
